- ➔ How to get maximum speed & range from your wireless routers.

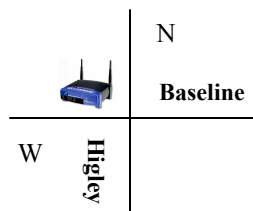
